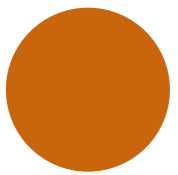

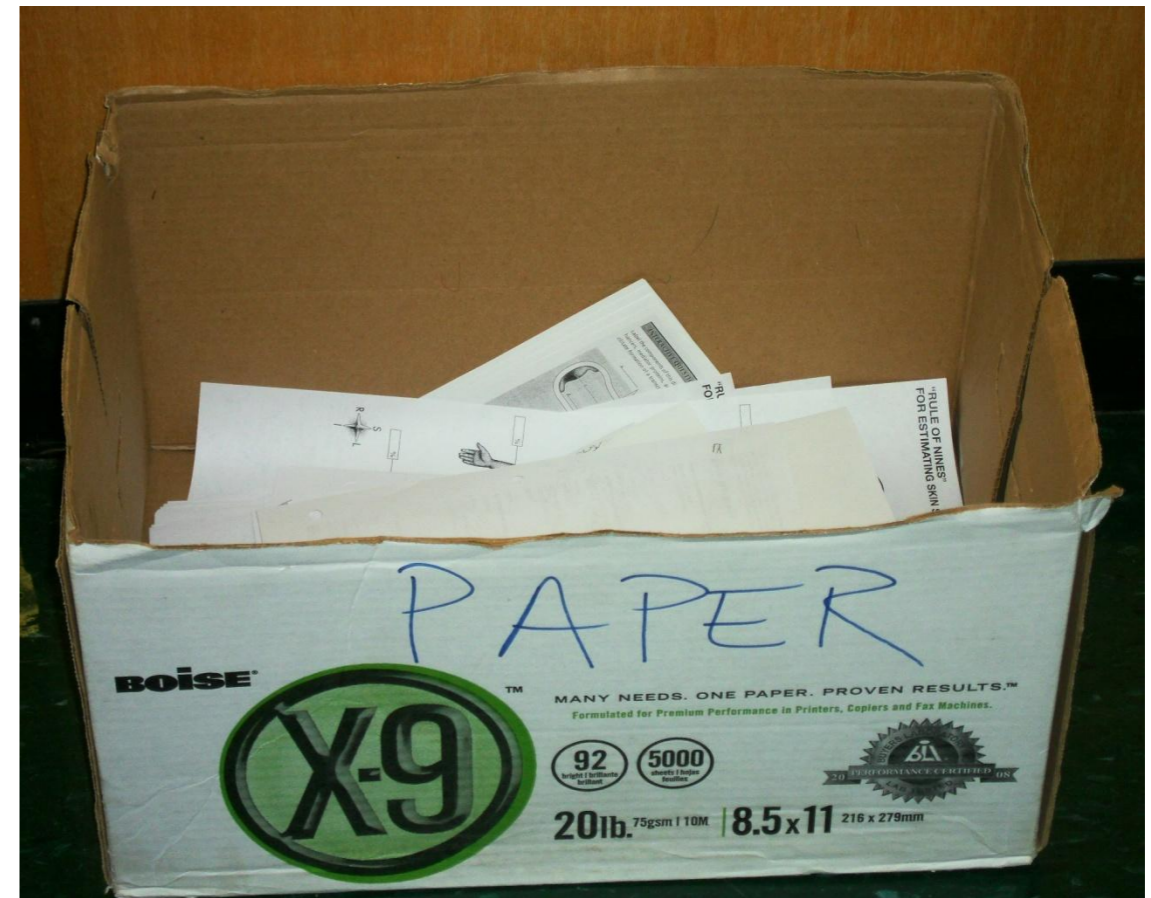
WE ARE THE GFW HIGH SCHOOL YES! TEAM

The GFW High School has 2 filling stations and has filled over 12,000 water bottles!



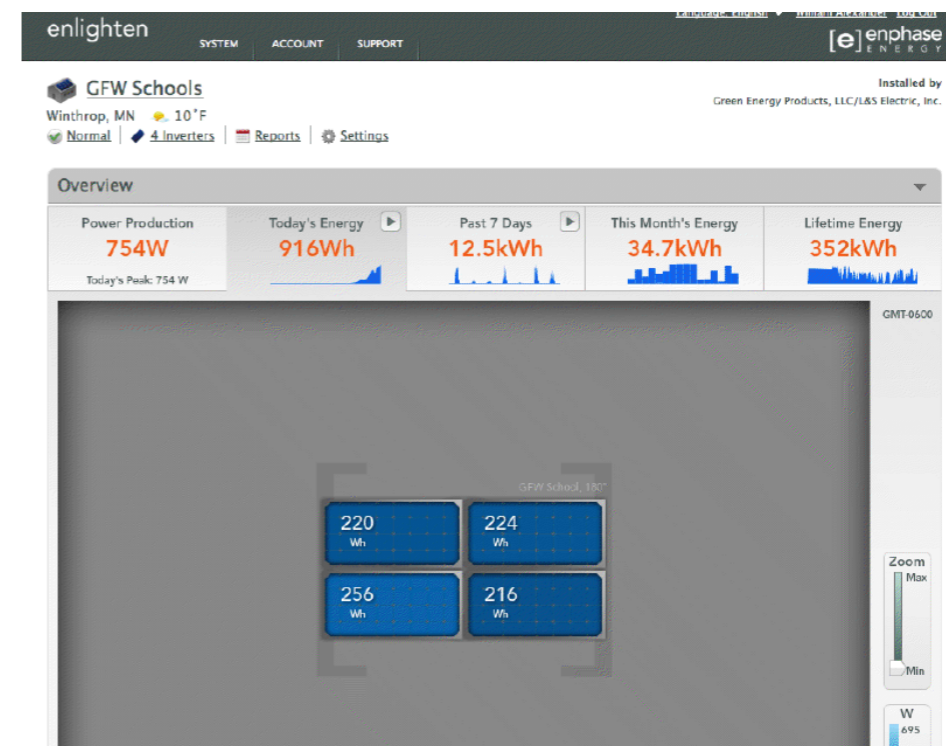
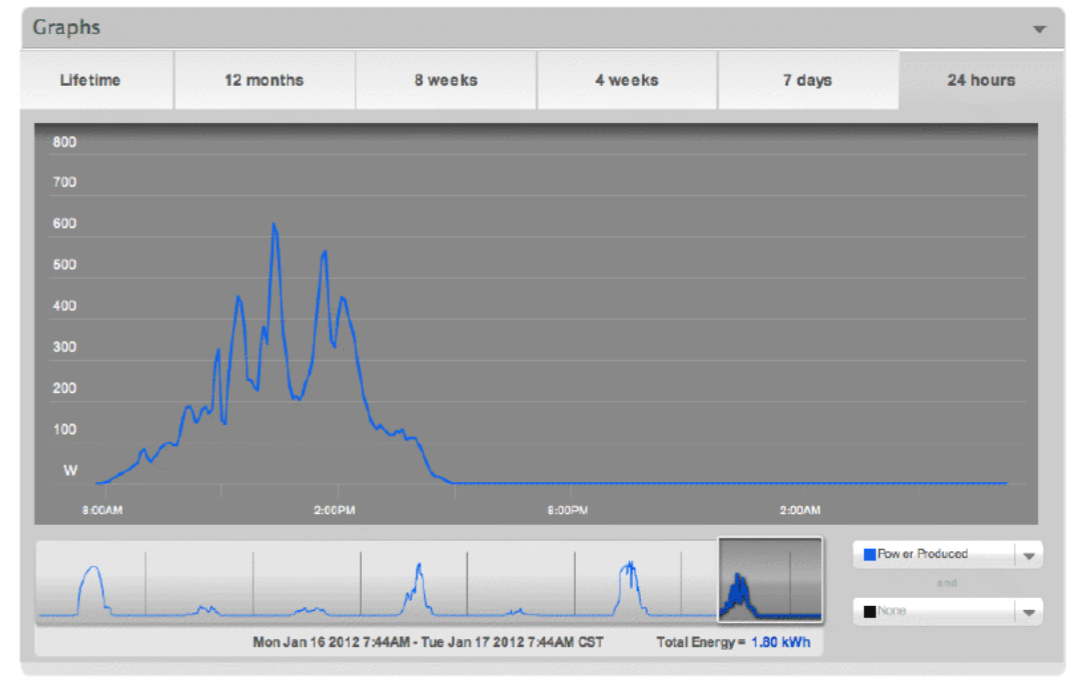
Compost

The GFW High School has composted 190 pounds of food!

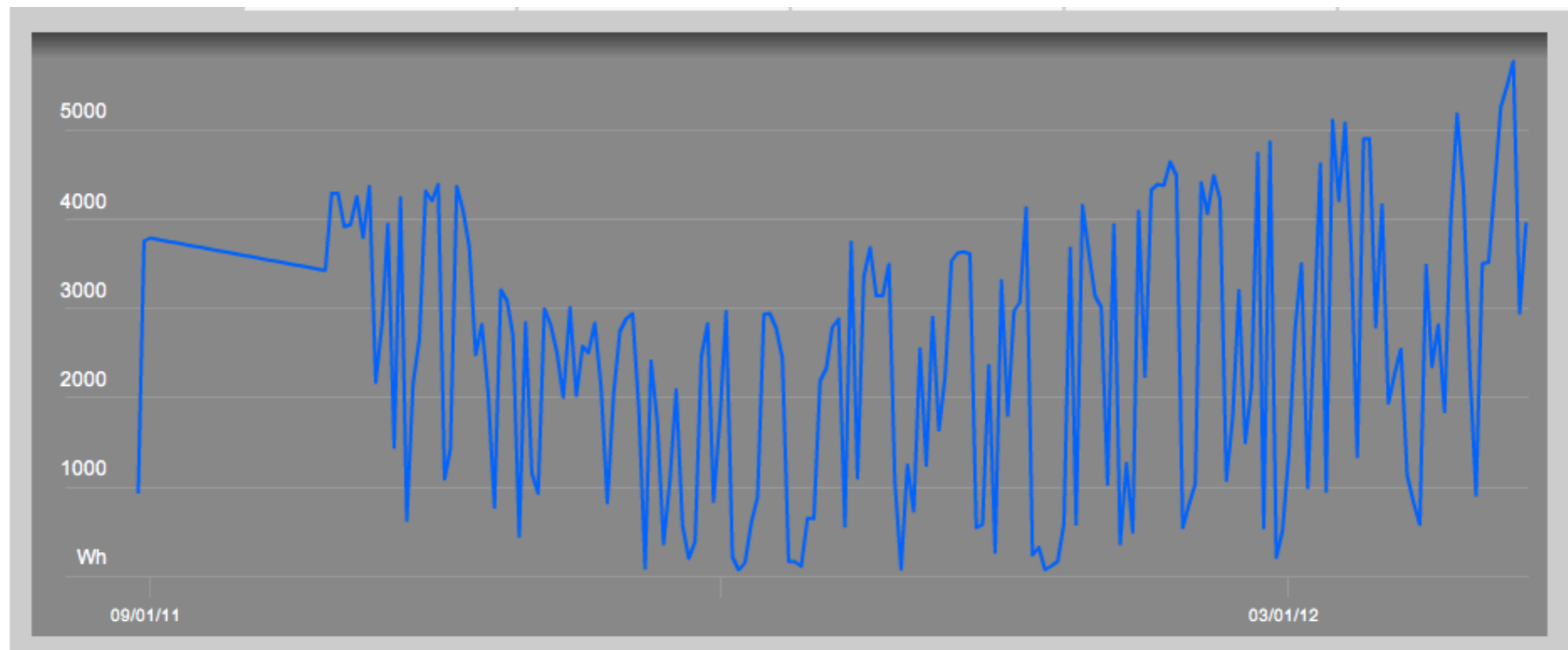


Solar Panels
