**Southern Update**: The Springfield team started growing plants with a hydroponic system. Due to some issues with a pump and timer, the students adapted the project by transplanting those seedlings into soil; they also plan to plant more seeds. ~Deb Groebner, South/Northeast Coordinator

**WC/C Update**: Minnewaska/WIN Academy and New London-Spicer YES! students participated in the "Lights!Water!Action" Kit workshop. They are doing a home Survey/audit to improve the energy and water efficiency in their home. They received 9 LED bulbs, an aerator, flow test kit and water leak detector tablets in each Kit to be used/installed at home. **T-Mobile Changemaker Challenge (Due April 8)**: Have an idea for technology, the environment, or education that would make communities more sustainable, connected, and inclusive? The <u>Changemaker Challenge</u> is a social innovation

challenge for young people (ages 13-18) in the U.S. Selected teams will receive **\$5,000 in seed funding**, on-going mentoring, and publicity to support their projects, and one grand prize winner will receive \$15,000 to supercharge their idea. The top 15 teams will also be invited to an all-expenses paid, three-day Changemaker Lab in Bellevue, WA focused on collaboration, storytelling, and skill development.
